A Fresh Start in a Smoke-Free Apartment

Live Smoke Free and RENT411 make it easy for renters to find smoke-free housing

ST. PAUL, MINN. – When spring arrives, we all begin to look forward to what the next few months will bring. For many Minnesotans, that includes looking forward to moving into a new apartment. We move for a variety of reasons, but some renters choose to move because they are exposed to secondhand smoke seeping into their current apartment from somewhere else in the building. Apartment hunters can go to Minnesota's Smoke-Free Multi-Housing Directory on Live Smoke Free's web site at www.mnsmokefreehousing.org. The directory is free to use and lists nearly 500 apartment buildings that are 100% smoke free, including in individual units.

"The number of smoke-free apartment buildings has grown significantly over the past few years," said Carissa Larsen of Live Smoke Free. "More and more, apartment owners and managers are recognizing the benefits of having an entirely smoke-free building and they are making the switch. This means that Minnesota renters have many more options for smoke-free living than they did a few years ago."

Apartment managers aren't the only ones recognizing the importance of smoke-free living. RENT411 is a Minnesota-based apartment, townhome and single-family home rental search service that publishes a print magazine for the Twin Cities and maintains a statewide web site. Recently, RENT411 teamed up with Live Smoke Free to create a quick, easy, and free way for renters to find smoke-free apartments using RENT411.

"We at RENT411 lost a dear friend and one of our longest tenured employees last year to cancer due to smoking. The topic of smoke-free living is near and dear to our hearts," said Seth Pasch, Customer Manager with RENT411. "Renters are in a unique situation to be exposed to the dangers of smoking, even if they are not smokers themselves. We want to help renters continue that healthy lifestyle by making it easy for them to find a smoke-free place to live."
