This symposium will examine the nexus of corruption and poverty - in particular, how corruption undermines Canadian humanitarian efforts to reduce poverty and promote human development. It will examine specifically the role of the Canadian International Development Agency (CIDA), the private sector and non-governmental organizations, with an additional focus on the need to take into account the economics, as well as the social and ethical dimensions, of health technology. As an overlay, it will probe what Canada needs to do to ensure its global credibility. Representatives from the private sector, NGO, government and research communities will explore issues that present some of the relevant challenges. We will seek to map out a research and action agenda that would help shape how Canada can enhance our humanitarian efforts.
